What to do:

1. **Call an ambulance, or go to your family doctor immediately after accident.** It is very common that you might not "feel" hurt at the scene due to shock. You will probably begin to get stiff and sore in the hours and days following the accident. At least go to the ER or your doctor to get checked out. Call us if you need a recommendation of a doctor.
2. **Call police, tell them there were injuries, and insist they come out and write a report.** The police report may be critical to helping you prove your case later.
3. **Take pictures of scene, vehicles, and other party. (Carry a disposable camera in your glove box.)**
4. **Do not talk to other side, and make no admissions or apologies.**
5. **Get names and telephone numbers of any witnesses.**
6. **Call *Street Law Firm* as soon as you are able.**
7. **DO NOT GIVE A STATEMENT TO THE INSURANCE COMPANY!** Let us do the talking for you. It is NEVER to your advantage to give a statement to an insurance company.
